Property Description	Known as it-Torri l-Abjad (the White Tower) or it-Torri tal-Ahrax, this tower stands on the tat-Ahrax peninsula at the extreme northern end of Malta. The tower is one of a series of thirteen fortified towers, built between 1658 and 1659, under Grand Master Martin de Redin. These towers were strong enough to withstand attack and				
	functioned as watch towers against corsair incursions. Each tower was also within				
	sight of its neighbours, creating a visual communication link between Gozo and the Grand Harbour.
