<b>Property Description</b>	Torri Mamo is small private tower built largely as a private country residence in 1657. In plan, it is built in the form of a St Andrew's Cross. It is enveloped by a low rock-hewn ditch but the structure is incomplete as it lacks the upper floor, which was never built. It has singular entrance. Inside the ditch lies a fourth century Roman Tomb.
