Property Description	Originally this building was commissioned by the GM de Wignacourt to house the				
Topeny Description	armory. The building became known as the Order's Chancellery as the documents				
	concerning the Order were transferred and to be stored under its roof, moreover, any				
	activities related to these archives were carried out here. The facade of this building is				
	rather plain, consisting of a rectangular door which is flanked by three large windows on each side. The windows are set within a panel having slightly projecting				
	sills and heavier cornices above the plain lintels. The ceilings of this building are				
	decorated by a series of frescoes which have been executed by Nicolo Nasoni.
