Property Description	<p>This Chapel can be found on the outskirts of the village. The place was known as 'tat-Torba'. This chapel was built in 1626, very near to the original place where the first one had been.</p> <p>Restoration works were carried out in 2001. External works were sponsored by the Qrendi Local Council, whilst internal works were carried out by volunteers under the guidance of Rev.Toledo, Parish Priest of Qrendi.</p>

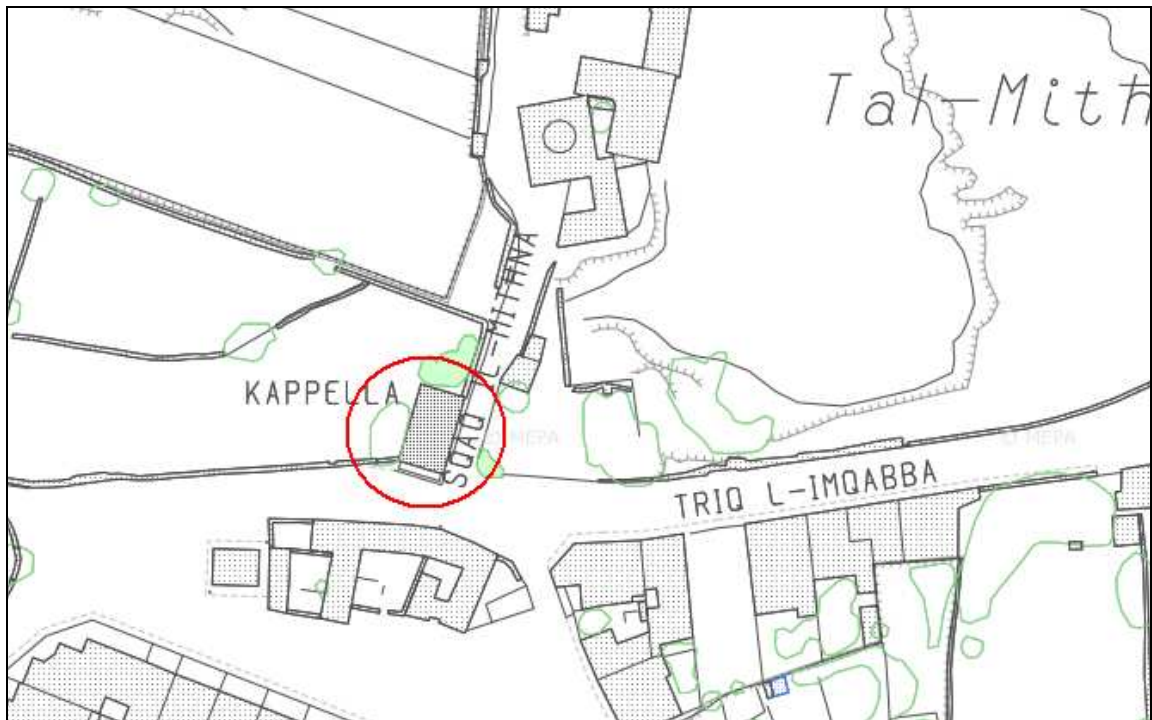
