Outline Description	Coastal redoubt
Property Description	Also known as Salina Right Redoubt, Ximenes Redoubt is one of the coastal works of fortification erected by the Knights in 1715/16. The structural originally consisted of a polygonal enclosure to which were added a series of rectangular warehouses for the storage of salt from the nearby Saline Nuove. The last of these alterations was made late in the 1770s during the reign of Grand Master Ximenes. A fougasse was also excavated within the redoubt after 1741, together with another one immediately outside its wall.

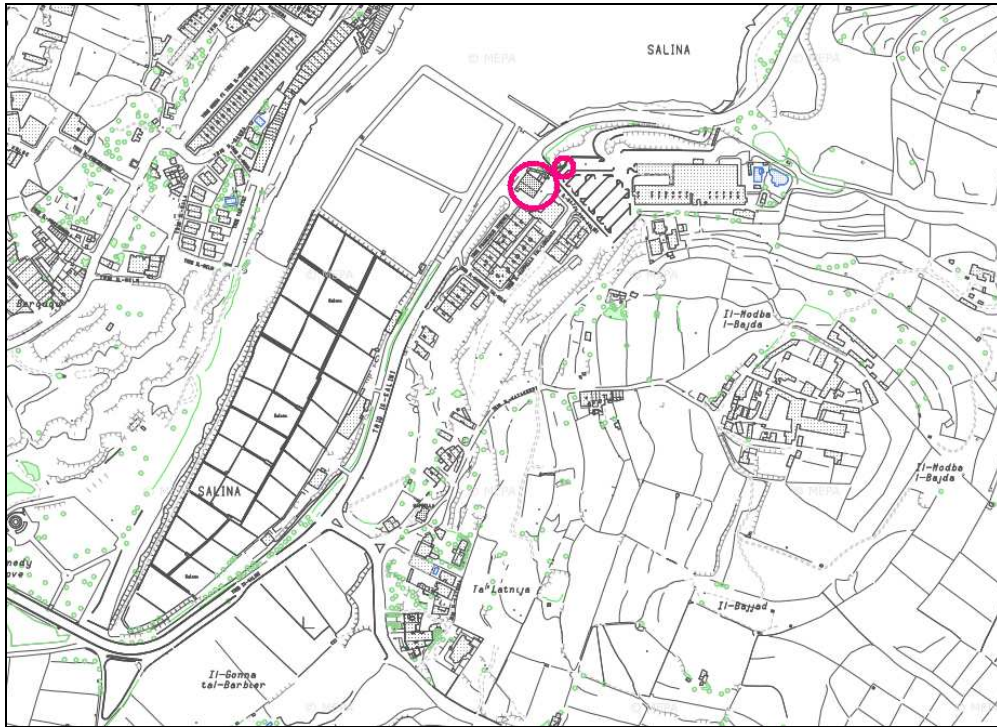
