Property Description

Rock-hewn traverse with accompanying ditch cut into shore line along the left side of Marsalforn Bay. This appears to date from the early 18th century coastal defences erected in the area after 1715. To the rear of the fougasse stands a rock-hewn fougasse cut into the side of the present-day road. This was partly damaged when it was cut into from the side.
