Outline Description	Church of Christ the Saviour
Property Description	<p>The original chapel was built in 1658 by Benedittu Camilleri, to replace an older chapel. It has a simple façade with a belfry on the top and a round window above the door. In 1876, two rectangular windows were added adjacent to the door, and a second door was added just behind the main portal. The chapel is reached by four steps and has a very small parvis. The door has a broken pediment with a frieze of vertical lines and guttae. The titular painting was also upgraded with an artistic perspective. The chapel gave temporary domicile to WW2 veterans, and also served as a classroom when the Primary School was overcrowded. In 1996, the chapel was restored, and is now used for the adoration of the Eucharist.</p>
